Registration of UG (II BTech, III BTech and IV BTech)

- Registration Dates:
01-08-2022 to 08-08-2020 (without fine)
10-08-2022 to 13-08-2022 (with fine)
- Mode of Registration: OFFLINE
- **Faculty advisor generated registration slip with duly signed signature of Faculty advisor and student is considered as the student is registered for the semester**
- Only those students will be permitted to register who have
 - i. Cleared all the Institute and Hostel dues of the previous semesters,
 - ii. Paid all required fees for the current semester, and
 - iii. Not been debarred from registering for a specified period on disciplinary or any other ground.
- Every student is required to register at the commencement of each semester on the day(s) notified in the Academic Calendar.
- The registration will be organized at the respective Department under the supervision of the Head of the Department.

Registration to II BTech from I Year (Those who joined for first year in the AY2021-22)

- **Student should have completed, with P or better grade, at least 22 credits at the end of first year.**
- A student must register the backlog courses, giving priority to the oldest backlogs.
- Student must produce and submit the photocopy of grade sheets in case of registering for backlogs during the registration.
- The students will register by default for the backlog courses being offered in a semester
- **The maximum credits (including backlog courses) that a student can register in the study mode in a semester is 30.**

Registration to III BTech from II BTech (Those who joined for first year in the AY2020-21)

- For promotion to Third year, a student should have
 - (i) Cleared all the course work requirements of I Year **and**
 - (ii) Passed, with P or better Grade, at least 28 credits in II Year I Semester, II Semester and makeup examinations put together

- There are no restrictions for promotion from odd semester to even semester in an academic year
- (i) A Student can register for a backlog subject whenever it is offered. His/her previous marks/grades are cancelled and will have to attend all classes and examinations as and when they are conducted. Major changes in the time table shall not be entertained to accommodate backlog students.
- A student must register for the backlog courses first giving priority to the oldest backlogs. [The students will register by default for backlog courses being offered in a particular semester].
- Student must produce and submit the photocopy of grade sheets in case of registering for backlogs during the registration.
- **The maximum credits (including backlog courses) that a student can register in a semester is 30.**

- (ii) Alternatively, a student can appear for make-up examination in the backlog subject as and when it is conducted.

Registration to IV BTech

(i) A Student can register for a backlog subject whenever it is offered. His/her previous marks/grades are cancelled and will have to attend all classes and examinations as and when they are conducted. Major changes in the time table shall not be entertained to accommodate backlog students.

- A student must register for the backlog courses first giving priority to the oldest backlogs. [The students will register by default for backlog courses being offered in a particular semester].
- Student must produce and submit the photocopy of grade sheets in case of registering for backlogs during the registration.
- **The maximum credits (including backlog courses) that a student can register in a semester is 30.**

(ii) Alternatively, a student can appear for make-up examination in the backlog subject as and when it is conducted.
